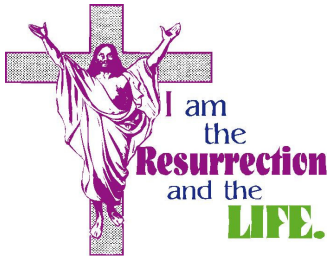

Regulations for Lent and the Easter Triduum

Lent is the principal season of penance in the Christian year. Priests, religious and laity are strongly urged to develop and follow a program of voluntary self-denial, attentiveness to prayer, and especially to works of charity and mercy.

Everyone of 14 years of age or over is bound to abstain from meat on all the Fridays in Lent.

Everyone 18 years of age and under 59 years of age is bound to fast on Good Friday, April 22, with only one full meatless meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted on these two days, but liquids including milk and fruit juices are allowed. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige. To disregard completely the law of fast and abstinence is a serious matter.

Come Pray the Rosary with the residents at 10:15 am this Monday, April 11, in the St. Clara's Manor Chapel. A gathering to pray the Rosary takes place on the second Monday of each month at St. Clara's Manor.

PRICE INCREASE FOR GRAVE SPACES

Due to the Logan County Cemetery Association increasing its price for grave spaces to \$700 each, prices at Holy Cross Cemetery and St. Mary's Cemetery will increase (from \$400) to \$550 per grave space effective June 1, 2011. This will help us offset the increased expenses caused by the new Illinois mandates and fees effective March 1, 2010.

At the 10 am Mass this Sunday, the participants in RCIA will take part in what is known as the "Scrutiny's". To scrutinize our lives, means to evaluate our living out of the commandments, to cleanse our inner "temple" of all that is keeping us from being a God-centered people. Recognizing that God knows what is in our hearts, we come humbly before our forgiving, loving God.

The scrutiny is an opportunity to examine or scrutinize our lives, our behavior, our choices, and to pray for the indwelling of the Holy Spirit to help us live a faith-filled life.

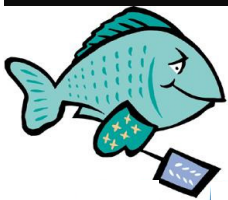

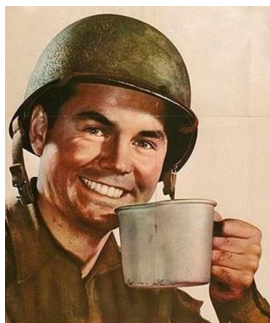
